Project Cambodia Overview

In conjunction with American Assistance for Cambodia and with co-financing by the Asian Development Bank, Global Playground has built a five-classroom school for middle school students in the country's Kandal Province. The school is maintained by the Cambodian Ministry of Education.

State of Education in Cambodia

Education plays a pivotal role in Cambodia's development. An estimated 40% of Cambodia's total population of 14 million is under the age of 18. Typically, Cambodian children attend school for four hours per day. Despite high student attendance, 26% of the population is illiterate, and only 64% of females are literate.

Latest Update

Global Playground is equipping the school with an additional 4 energy efficient computers and 3 new solar panels, for a total 5 computers and 6 solar panels.
