Project Honduras Overview

Global Playground, in partnership with the organization Students Helping Honduras, is building a new technology center within a learning center for over 200 impoverished children in El Progreso, Honduras. Equipped with 18 computers, educational software, and broadband internet, and a full-time technology instructor, the technology center will be an integral part of the learning center. It will also serve as Global Playground's launch pad for global cross-cultural dialogue.

State of Education in Honduras

With nearly two thirds of its population living below the poverty line, Honduras is the second poorest country in the Western Hemisphere. Due to the limited funds allocated to public expenditures, the majority of public schools in Honduras are underfunded and lack the necessary resources to provide quality education. It is estimated that only 90% of the country's population is literate and over 13% of children do not attend school.

Latest Update

The technology center is expected to open in May 2010.
