Project Uganda Overview

In December 2008, Global Playground opened its first project: an 8-classroom primary school in the village of Buwasa, Wakiso District, Uganda. The school was built in collaboration with our local partner organization Building Tomorrow. Since 2008, the school has served around 325 children in Buwasa and five neighboring villages.

State of Education in Uganda

School-age children in sub-Saharan Africa have lower rates of attendance than children in almost every other region of the world. Uganda is no exception. In rural areas of Uganda, including Wakiso District, less than 50% of children under 18 years old are within a reasonable distance to attend a local school. Moreover, the Government of Uganda struggles to meet the needs of its young population due to weak infrastructure.

Latest Updates

In order to ensure dependable sources of daily electricity, Global Playground is looking into installing approximately 10 solar panels at the school.
